- If we do sell to Old Timers this could give us a larger cushion to prepurchase shirts to sell at A Gray Matter and Oranges.
- Today is the last day I'll be taking pre-orders. The form is closed, but if anyone has not ordered who wants to, they can email me directly.
- Melody has contacted me & should have put in a quote for 2 buckets of paint - this has been approved by Nick. I'll be able to pick up the paint sometime this week.
